Development Issue	<p>【Background and current situation】 As Barbados is a Small Island Developing State, natural disasters such as hurricanes, tropical storms and flooding rain constitute a threat to its economic development. Since Barbados is forced to depend on imported fossil fuels as its main energy resource, it is obligated to introduce renewable energy sources and promote energy efficiency. Although waste recycling efforts led by private entities are developed in the field of waste management and this system became a model for the neighbouring island countries, it is still required to strengthen the administrative capacity in the waste management sector.</p>			<p>【Strategy】 Noting the necessity of coordination and knowledge sharing with the neighbouring island countries and based on the result of studies on the levels of assistance needed, Japan will extend necessary assistance to overcome vulnerabilities which are particular to Small Island Developing States in the field of disaster risk management, energy efficiency, renewable energy and waste management etc.</p>
