

JAPANESE GOVERNMENT (MEXT) SCHOLARSHIP Programme 2021

The Government of Japan through the Embassy of Japan in Barbados is currently inviting applications from persons who wish to study at universities in Japan under the Japanese Government (MEXT) Scholarship Programme 2021. This programme is open to Research Students only.

Attributes of applicants

Applicants must be Barbadian nationals, born on or after April 2, 1986 in principle, in possession of at least a university degree and willing to learn the Japanese language for six months at the beginning of their research study. Benefits include a monthly stipend, paid tuition and one return ticket.

Period of scholarship

From September or October 2021 to March 2023
(incl. six months of Japanese language training)
