



Japan contributes globally to the implementation of United Nation's Women, Peace and Security (WPS) agenda, which underscores the pivotal role women play in achieving peace and security. The WPS Task Force initiated by Foreign Minister KAMIKAWA Yoko, within the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Japan, aims to further strengthen Japan's efforts to ensure issues impacting women and thus, issues impacting peace and security are addressed.

Such a concerted effort to mainstream gender into Japan's policies is clearly demonstrated in its assistance to the Ukraine. In partnership with UN agencies, Japan has provided maternal care, educational opportunities for children and E-commerce support for women-led small businesses. Moreover, Japan has sought to tackle women rights violation by developing Ukrainian law enforcement's ability to prevent human trafficking and gender based violence.
