Outline of the Project

The purpose of the project is to support the work programme of Princess Margaret Hospital, as it seeks to improve the unit's capacity to offer occupational therapy, psycho drama and group psychotherapy, as well as to provide a more integrated form of treatment for both inpatients and day patients.

The grant was used for the construction of a wooden prefabricated building and the provision of kitchen utensils.

Since the completion of this project, the Princess Margaret Hospital has become better equipped to provide the appropriate care for people who are afflicted by mental health problems.
