

Deputy Chief NAKAE Pays a Courtesy Call on Ms. Sonia E. Boyce, Commissioner of the Barbados Police Service



On August 25, Deputy Chief of Mission Mr. Arata Nakae visited the Barbados Police Service Headquarters and paid a courtesy call on Ms. Sonia E. Boyce, Commissioner of the Barbados Police Service. During the meeting, the two sides confirmed the Barbados Police Service's cooperation in ensuring the safety and well-being of Japanese nationals in the event of accidents, natural disasters, or other emergencies. They also agreed to exchange relevant information to facilitate a swift and effective response in emergencies, further strengthening cooperation between Japan and Barbados in the areas of public safety and crisis management.

Commissioner Boyce noted that disaster management and emergency response are also important responsibilities of the police. She expressed her hope that Barbados would benefit from Japan's extensive experience in disaster preparedness and response, and looked forward to opportunities for knowledge-sharing through future training programs and other initiatives.
